## The project

### Scenarios to 2020



**MMWD** is a strategic project co-funded by the **Transnational Cooperation Programme for South East Europe** (SEE), through the **ERDF** and **IPA**. The Emilia-Romagna Region is the leading partner of 21 partners, mostly public administrations, in 9 countries: Italy, Austria, Slovenia, Montenegro, Serbia, Bulgaria, Romania, Moldova, Greece, along with the participation of the IOM as observer.



MMWD investigates the implications of demographic change on the effectiveness of territorial development strategies to 2020. Population projections and analysis of the effects of demographic change on employment, human capital and welfare systems are brought together in MMWD regional scenarios. Comparability among MMWD scenarios is ensured by a common reference: Europe 2020 and its objectives.


